The Proceedings will contain original scientific and professional articles, book reviews and other publications. All articles will undergo a peer review and will be categorized according to the classification of scientific and professional articles.

Since the articles can be written in co-authorship (up to 3 authors per article), the graduate students and the alumni are recommended to prepare and submit joint professional or scientific articles with their professors. The articles will be published if they meet the criteria for the publication of professional and scientific articles and get two positive peer reviews. One author can publish a maximum **of two articles** in one issue of the Proceedings. Please note that the article should not exceed 15 pages (B5 format, 2.5 margins, font 10, single spacing).

The final body of the article has to be submitted no later than **June 30 2017** (in the attachment you will find the application form „**Authorship statement form**” that has to be signed and sent with the article). After this date, the final texts of the articles will not be accepted under any circumstances.

The final body of the article has to be submitted to the Editor-in-Chief prof. Branko Wasserbauer, PhD, or the Secretary of the Editorial Board Ivana Varičak (or must be sent by registered mail to the Editorial board of the Proceedings of the Karlovac University of Applied Sciences, Trg J. J. Strossmayera 9, Karlovac, Croatia) in **hard-copy**, with the name and surname of the authors stated; and it must be sent to the e-mail address [zbornik@vuka.hr](mailto:zbornik@vuka.hr).

You will find the **Instructions for Authors** on the web pages of the Karlovac University of Applied Sciences. The works of all authors whose articles will be published in the Proceedings must adhere to these guidelines.

The Editorial Board of the Proceedings will make the final decision on acceptance or rejection of the submitted articles with the necessary explanations. The final decision will be made only after your article is given a positive review by impartial and highly qualified reviewers who have **to be of higher** teaching or research vocation than the author(s).

The Editorial Board will inform you about the final decision no later than **17<sup>th</sup> December 2017**.
